Bressingham is open daily from 28th March to 28th October in 2018. Prices and operating railways vary dependant on the day. Check online for details

### Steam days

Weds to Sundays – School and public holidays. At least 2 trains and the Gallopers running. Sundays and BHM we aim for 3 Narrow Gauge lines and steam on the Standard Gauge line.

### Gardeners days

Our Green days are a perfect time to visit for gardeners. One diesel hauled train and the Gallopers running.

### Entry Only

Entry only tickets are available for any day and include everything other than rides – these can be bought as you go if required.

### Season ticket

The best way to repeat visit Bressingham. Season tickets are valid for a year from purchase and provide daytime entry and rides during our open season.

## The Bressingham Gardens

These unique Bressingham Gardens are renowned worldwide for their horticultural excellence.

Privately owned by the Bloom family, Adrian Bloom and his father Alan have each created a six acre garden, the Dell and Foggy Bottom.

Together with four linking gardens, there are now 8,000 species and varieties on display in 17 acres.
