Bressingham Bricks: A LEGO Fan Exhibition: Saturday 15th & Sunday 16th July 2019

As part of Bressingham's exciting and varied Events Programme we have the pleasure in inviting you to attend our 2019 'Bressingham Bricks' exhibition to be held at the Museum on 16th & 17th June 2019. This is the first time the museum will have held such an event and we are hoping you can join us to make the event a success.

The exhibition will be held in the main exhibition hall which features a variety of steam engines and a Dad's Army display. This is the same hall in which the museum hosts its annual model railway shows.

The museum is able to provide 6ft tables and chairs for exhibitors. Complimentary hot and cold refreshments will be available throughout the weekend.

For those exhibitors wishing to stay overnight in caravan's/tents, ample space will be provided - please indicate on the enclosed entry form if you wish to reserve a space. The campsite for displays/vehicles will be available from the evening of Friday 14th June. We can provide a list of B&B's and hotels for anyone who is interested.

Please note that Dogs are not allowed on the main museum site when open to the public. If you decide to camp dogs are allowed on the camping field area only.

The museum will discount its entry price for the event for pre booked online ticket sales. Adults will be £6.50 and with Children prices slightly less (price tbc). This allows for entry to the whole museum site and 17 acres of gardens.

Bressingham Steam Museum is Charity and has been open to the public since 1961. Diversifying the events calendar aims to bring more people to the museum. Proceeds help the museum in its aims to restore and present working steam engines to the public. The museum is currently working on the restoration of an historic 15" steam locomotive which it hopes can run again for passengers in 2020.
